The Sacramento SPCA's Camp Kindness is a fun-filled way for kids to learn more about dogs, cats, and other companion animals. Camp Kindness is designed to foster awareness about animals, and will include games, crafts, tours, guest speakers, animal-related education, professional demonstrations, veterinary observation, discussions, and plenty of fun!

CAMP BASICS

- Campers should be able to work well with others, and with animals in a group situation.
- Because of the popularity of Camp Kindness, we are taking registration on a first-come, first-served basis. All applications must be received no later than June 13, but we recommend submitting yours as early as possible. **Camp sessions will probably be full prior to the deadline.** Your application must be completed in full, and payment must accompany your application.
- We cannot guarantee that each camp session will be equally mixed with gender and race. We will, however, make sure that no session has only one boy or one girl.
- Your child must be within the age range for the session(s) you request. We offer two sessions for ages 7-9 and three sessions for ages 10-12 every summer. Please don't ask us to make exceptions for your child to accommodate your family's schedule.
- Camp sessions are one week long, and run from **8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.** Transportation is not provided and timely drop-off and pick-up is a must.
- Campers are expected to wear appropriate clothing for animal contact.
- Allergies to cats and/or dogs will be impossible to accommodate.
- Opportunities for socialization with SSPCA animals are subject to the availability of appropriate animals.

APPLYING FOR CAMP

- Application deadline is June 13, 2008.
- All applications must be received by the SSPCA no later than 5:00 PM on Friday, June 13.
- A separate application and check must be sent for each child applying for camp. Camp fee is **\$145.00.**

***Important financial aid information:** Campers applying for financial aid who have previously attended one or more sessions of either Summer, Spring or Holiday Camp Kindness will be automatically placed on the waiting list for the session(s) they wish to enroll in, regardless of whether that session is full at the time their application is received. If their chosen session is not full as of June 6, 2008, these applicants will be notified and enrolled. This does not apply to first-time campers applying for financial aid, whose applications will be processed normally in the order in which they are received. Our financial aid policy will allow more first-time campers to attend the program. Thanks for your cooperation!

CAMP ACCEPTANCE AND NOTIFICATION

- If Camp Kindness sessions are full at the time your application is received, you will be notified and your check will be returned to you by mail.
- Applicants who are selected for a session will receive further instructions and information by mail.
- Some applicants may receive notification of their status on the waiting list.
- When your application is received, please allow one week to receive confirmation by mail of your child's enrollment.
