## **Pet First Aid Kit Checklist**









| The phone number, name and address of your vet   |

| The phone number of an Animal Poison Control Center  |
| Your pet's medical record (medications, vaccination history)   |
| Gauze (for wrapping wounds)  |
| Adhesive tape (to secure the gauze wrap or a bandage)  |
| Cotton balls or swabs  |
| <b>3% hydrogen peroxide</b> (to induce vomiting, must be fresh & check with your vet or animal poison control expert before giving this to your pet) |
| Milk of magnesia or activated charcoal (to absorb poison, check with your vet or animal poison control expert before giving to your pet)             |
| <b>Digital thermometer</b> (need a fever thermometer that goes high enough for pets)   |
| Ice pack   |
| Disposable gloves  |
| Scissors with a blunt end  |
| Tweezers   |
| Antibiotic ointment  |
| Liquid washing detergent (for bathing)   |
| Towels   |
| Small flashlight   |
| Oral syringe or kitchen baster   |
| Alcohol wipes  |
| Styptic powder (to stop bleeding from cutting nail quicks)   |
| Saline eye solution  |
| Artificial tear gel  |
