

ANIMALS SURRENDERED BY OWNERS

Surrender fee is \$50.00 per animal, \$100 for two and \$25.00 for a 3rd and additional animal \$100 for a litter (under 4 months) with an appointment*

Without an appointment, walk-in fees are an additional \$50 per pet

*If you are late for your appointment a late fee will apply:

\$15 up to 30min, \$25 up to 1hour, 1hour or more must pay walk-in fee

Fees must be paid in full at the time of intake and are nonrefundable.

Sacramento SPCA Policy Statement

By surrendering an animal to the Sacramento SPCA you agree to the following:

1. I declare that I am the legal owner of the animal(s) surrendered and understand that under F&A Code 31108.5 and 31752.2 that any person who provides false information pursuant to this subdivision about his or her ownership of animal(s) shall be liable to the true owner of the animal in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00).
2. I am forfeiting all rights of ownership of the animal(s) to the Sacramento SPCA. I will not be able to visit the animal(s) after I have surrendered.
3. The Sacramento SPCA does not guarantee the adoption of any animal surrendered.
4. I understand that the animal(s) I am surrendering may be euthanized (humanely put to death).
5. Once I surrender the animal(s), they may be immediately placed. If I wish to reclaim any animal(s) I surrendered, it must be approved by Sacramento SPCA. Sacramento SPCA has the right to deny reclaims. Only the surrendering party may request a reclaim and would be responsible for all reclaim fees, listed below*. All animal(s) will be altered (spayed/neutered) prior to release, as listed under F&A Code 30520(b).
6. The SSPCA does not provide information on the status or outcome of the animal(s) surrendered.
7. If the animal(s) you are surrendering has a microchip, the Sacramento SPCA will contact the registered party to let them know an animal registered to them has been surrendered to our facility. If you are not the legal owner, the legal owner has a right to pursue a civil suit under F&A Code 31108.5 and 31752.2, as stated in line 1.

Animals that will not be placed into our Adoption Program:

- If they are under eight weeks of age or unweaned*
- If their advanced age is causing medical or physical problems, if he/she is in critical condition, or he/she has a contagious disease*
- If they are in poor general health or physical condition*
- If their temperament or behavior is such that they would not adapt well to a new home

**Note - Under certain circumstances animals may be euthanized before the holding period is over.*

*Fees that will apply to reclaiming animal(s):

Boarding \$15 per day**Holidays and closed days included*

Microchip \$25


Spay/neuter (fees vary)

DHPP/Bordetella/FVRCP \$20each

Rabies \$6

Animal licensing (fees vary)

Medical exam and/or treatments/testing (fees vary)



RANCHO CORDOVA AND FOLSOM STRAY ANIMALS RECEIVED

Sacramento SPCA Policy Statement

The following are Sacramento SPCA procedures regarding incoming stray animals:

1. I am surrendering this stray animal(s) to the Sacramento SPCA and declare that I have found this animal within the City Limits of Rancho Cordova or the City of Folsom. If the animal(s) is not a stray found in Rancho Cordova or Folsom or owned by myself, family or household member, I understand that I will be responsible for all fees. Fees will include stray holding boarding at \$25 a day and City officer time per hour.
2. I have been notified that by law, all stray animals will be held for a minimum 3-day holding period* to provide pet owners the opportunity to reclaim their animals.
3. At the end of the 3-day holding period, if not reclaimed by its owner, the animal will become the property of the Sacramento SPCA.
4. I understand that I have no rights or ability to reclaim the animal as I am not the legal owner. No information will be provided to me on the animal once he/she is placed in the care of the Sacramento SPCA.
5. If I am interested in adopting the animal(s), I acknowledge that I must do so through the Adoption Center. No hold will be placed on this animal for future adoption, nor will I be notified when/if the animal is available for adoption.

Animals that will not be placed into our Adoption Program:

The following is a list of conditions where an animal may not be placed for adoption:

- If they are under eight weeks of age*
- If their advanced age is causing medical or physical problems, if he/she is in critical condition, or he/she has a contagious disease*
- If they are in poor general health or physical condition*
- If their temperament or behavior is such that they would not adapt well to a new home

*Note - Under certain circumstances animals may be euthanized before the holding period is over.
